Sodexo is committed to actively identifying those elements of the business that impact on the environment and, where possible, eliminating or reducing these through the development of management practices and procedures involving systematic planning, operational control, monitoring and review.

In pursuit of our business goals we will adhere to the following principles:

Commit to a process of continuous improvement through the setting and reviewing of environmental objectives and targets to minimise the wastage of raw materials and energy from our activities.

Comply with all applicable environmental legislation and, where regulations do not exist, set our own standards for environmental performance.

Conduct internal reviews and audits to monitor performance and to assess compliance with company policies and procedures.

Inform our suppliers and contractors of our environmental policies and monitor their performance to ensure that the goods and services they provide meet our environmental objectives.

Inform customers and clients of our initiatives and encourage them to fully consider the environmental implications of their business activities. Where appropriate, we will seek their assistance to help us to achieve our environmental goals.

Make employees aware of this policy and provide them with such information, instruction and training as necessary to ensure they comply with the requirements of this policy.

Ensure business and other senior directors implement this policy and that Sodexo UK and Ireland reports publicly on progress against objectives and targets.

This policy will be monitored to ensure it is effective and revised as necessary and shall be made available to all interested parties.
